Dear Mr. Szymanski,

The Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") has enclosed a draft Trading Agreement and Orders No. 8137A which allows trading of nitrogen oxides ("NOx") emission reductions for non-NOx Budget Program sources until April 30, 2007, for review and signature by an authorized representative of the United States Army Stratford Army Engine Plant.

The owner and operators of sources that use emission reduction trading as their compliance method will be in violation of Section 22a-174-22, if they do not have a Trading Agreement and Order in place.

Please return the original Trading Agreement and Order signed by an authorized representative of the United States Army Stratford Army Engine Plant within fourteen (14) calendar days of your receipt of the Trading Agreement and Order.

Once the original signed Trading Agreement is received by the Department, it will be presented to the Commissioner for signature. If signed by the Commissioner, Trading Agreement and Order No. 8137A will become a Final Order of the Commissioner and a certified copy of the Trading Agreement and Order will be returned to you via registered mail.
