Subject: DISPOSAL OF SCRAP LICENSED MATERIAL

This letter refers to the telecopy of your letter dated August 20, 1993, informing us of the status of scrap thoriated-magnesium (Mg-Th) that you are holding.

We understand that because of circumstances involving the return of Mg-Th scrap from Magnesium Elektron Limited in England, management restructuring of the salvage control operation, and the need to find an alternate method of disposal of the Mg-Th scrap, Textron Lycoming, Stratford Division, will not be able to dispose of Mg-Th scrap until after October 31, 1993.

If our understanding of this matter is not correct, please advise us in writing as soon as possible.

You have apparently been not in compliance with condition 12 of License No. STB-393 for a period in excess of five months. To avoid enforcement action, we strongly urge that you take aggressive action to correct the violation. Please keep us informed of your progress.
