Dear Dr. Fleming:

The Waste Management Bureau has received your correspondence regarding the contaminated soil from a site remediation project at the Textron Lycoming Stratford facility. Based upon the review of information supplied to the Department, this material appears to be non-hazardous and suitable for removal to an approved waste disposal facility.

The Waste Engineering & Enforcement Division issues written authorization for these types of materials to local solid waste disposal facilities with the recommendation that the soil be utilized as a cover material at the landfill. Particle size distribution analysis information indicates that this material would be suitable for daily cover material and a small portion may be suitable for intermediate and/or final cover material (final cover > 20 per cent fines). Requirements for cover materials are outlined in the Solid Waste Regulations (Section 22a-209-1 and 22a-209-7(1)) and in "Guidelines For Engineering Evaluations of Solid Waste Disposal Areas".

The list of solid waste disposal facilities obtained from the Waste Engineering & Enforcement Division should be contacted to ascertain if they are in need of additional cover materials. Upon completion of all negotiations between the concerned parties, the Waste Management Bureau can provide written authorization for use of the excavated material as approved landfill cover. Please provide the Waste Engineering & Enforcement Division/Solid Waste Section with information as to the selected solid waste disposal area and the approximate volume of material to be removed during site remediation activities.
