Enclosed please find the RCRA Part B Permit Application and Closure Plan for the Avco Lycoming Textron, Stratford Army Engine Plant, in Stratford, Connecticut.

The RCRA Part B Permit Application is being submitted in compliance with those requirements in Section 213 of "The Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984". The enclosed information addresses the operation of our four (4) hazardous waste storage surface impoundments at the above mentioned facility.

Please note that the facility Closure Plan is being submitted under separate cover. Avco Lycoming Textron plans on closing the four hazardous waste surface impoundments in May 1986, therefore, the Closure Plan should be reviewed with this date in mind.

The amended RCRA Part A Permit Application will be submitted because some of the operations that were listed in the Part A as being hazardous waste treatment or storage activities are no longer defined under RCRA or the Connecticut DEP as being hazardous waste treatment or storage activities. In addition, other minor changes will be incorporated into the amended Part A.
