Dear Mr. Myer:

During an inspection on April 18, 1986 by staff of the CTDEP and EPA, a number of deficiencies were noted in the groundwater monitoring program at the Avco Lycoming Textron facility in Stratford. They are detailed in the attached reports. As a result of this inspection an Abatement Order will be issued to require investigation of rate and extent of contaminant migration and degree of groundwater contamination present at the Avco facility.

DEP does not propose to impose civil penalties at this time; however, AVCO Lycoming Textron's performance on groundwater quality assessment will be closely monitored for compliance with the administrative order.
