In response to our telecon of 1/20/82 regarding the Avco Lycoming NPDES Discharge Permit, I have enclosed a copy of a letter to you from Peter Bonitatebus (dated 6/16/80). This letter, which acknowledges receipt of the permit and assures compliance with Paragraphs 1 through 7, must be the letter you are looking for.

I have further spoken with Chester Yee of the Corps of Engineers and he feels that the following time table appears realistic regarding the CWTP (008 Discharge).

The Weston Study regarding the plant should follow this schedule:
