
On April 17, 1987, I submitted a letter to your agency regarding an extension to the closure schedule for the subject project at Stratford, Connecticut.

In that letter, I stated that prior to revising the closure plan, a contractual modification and a notice to proceed had to be issued to Metcalf & Eddy.

Please be advised that the contractual modification and notice to proceed was issued on May 1, 1987. Metcalf & Eddy will submit a draft closure plan for review by U.S. Army Aviation Systems Command, U.S. Army Material Command and Avco Lycoming Textron by May 26, 1987. After their review, the final version of the closure plan will be submitted to your office and the U.S. E.P.A. Region I by June 23, 1987.
