Enclosed please find the Annual Summary Groundwater Report for the fourteenth year Groundwater Monitoring Assessment Program at the Stratford Army Engine Plant operated by AlliedSignal Engines in Stratford, Connecticut. The report is required by Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection regulations 22a-449(c)-100 through 110 and 22a-449(c)-11, as revised July 17, 1990. It is prepared in accordance with the requirements referenced.

This work was performed and prepared by Sound Environmental Solutions in continuing our Groundwater Monitoring Program. The procedure continues to compare groundwater quality to Connecticut Public Drinking Water Code and US EPA Maximum Contaminant Levels and US EPA Secondary Maximum Contaminant Levels. The summary has been written in such a way as to update the findings but simplify the presentation, how-be-it that it is lengthy.

It is to be noted that the metals concentration are now not a concern.
