Dear Mr. Shteynberg:

Enclosed you will find the Groundwater Assessment Monitoring Report for the fourteenth year, second quarter from the September 16, 1997 sampling at the Stratford Army Engine Plant operated by AlliedSignal Engines in Stratford, Connecticut.

This work was performed, the report prepared, and delivered to us by Mr. Thomas Hughes of Sound Environmental Solutions in continuing our Groundwater Monitoring Assessment Program.

We have reviewed the report and findings and are now submitting the report to you. A continued downward trend of the metals concentration still is seen, all being below the drinking standard. The concentration of vinyl chloride is still reflecting a degradation of the chlorinated organics.

Production at the plant has ceased and closure of the AlliedSignal operations is in progress. It is anticipated that transition of the activities at the installation remaining to the U.S.Army before the next monitoring activity scheduled for March 10, 1998.
