Enclosed is the September 1992 Aquatic Toxicity Monitoring Report for discharges 007 and 008 for the Textron Lycoming facility.

The 007 discharge passed both the acute and chronic toxicity limits. The 008 discharge from the Chemical Waste Treatment Plant passed the acute toxicity limit but not the chronic toxicity limit for the Mysidopsis bahia. New England Bioassay, Inc. is continuing with the Toxicity Identification Evaluation in order to determine the cause(s) of occasional chronic toxicity problems on the Mysidopsis bahia. Numerous toxicity and analytical tests performed to date in the investigation have not proven conclusive.
