I am writing as follow up to our electronic mails dated September 18, 2008.

Enclosed is a revised draft of Consent Order No. 1924, which requires the submission of a revised NOx Compliance Plan for the boilers and a civil penalty payment of \$19,169.

The violations describe in this draft Order are federal high priority violations and are on EPA's violation watch list.

Please sign and return the enclosed Consent Order with your signature within ten (10) calendar days of your receipt of the Order. Once the signed Consent Order is received by the Department, it will be presented to the Commissioner for signature. If signed by the Commissioner, Consent Order No. 1924 will become a final Order of the Commissioner and a certified copy of the Consent Order will be returned to you via registered mail.

The failure to submit and consent to the Order within 10 days will result in the Department referring this matter to the U.S. EPA.
