Gentlemen:

Under Sections 22a-430-6 and 22a-430-7 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies permit fees are now being required for all discharge permits. A copy of the regulations is enclosed for your review.

The present system requires the payment of three fees:

- Payment of a permit issuance fee required for issuance of all new permits.
