Gentlemen:

Under Sections 22a-430-6 and 22a-430-7 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies permit fees are now being required for all discharge permits. A copy of the regulations is enclosed for your review.

The present system requires the payment of three fees:

- Tentative determination fee - required for issuance of all permits.
- Payment of a permit issuance fee - required for issuance of all new permits.
- An annual fee required for issuance of a permit and thirty days before a permit anniversary date annually thereafter.

The permit will be issued without an accompanying or incorporated order. Therefore the following fees are currently due:

- Tentative Determination Fee of \$750.00
- Permit Issuance Fee of \$650.00
- Annual Fee of \$1,150.00

Total fees = \$2,550.00
