IN THE MATTER OF AN ORDER TO AVCO LYCOMING DIVISION, AVCO CORPORATION TO ABATE POLLUTION

O R D E R


Having found that AVCO Lycoming Division, AVCO Corporation is maintaining a facility which no longer insures or adequately protects against pollution to the waters of the state under the provisions of Chapter 446k, Connecticut General Statutes as amended, the Commissioner of Environmental Protection acting under Section 22a-431 hereby Orders AVCO Lycoming Division, AVCO Corporation to take such action as is necessary to:

1. Make necessary modifications to process and treatment operations and/or install additional treatment facilities for the proper treatment of oily wastewaters which comprise Discharge Serial No. 007, and come into compliance with NPDES Permit No. CT0002984 issued on May 20, 1980.

AVCO Lycoming Division, AVCO Corporation is further Ordered to accomplish the above described program, except as may be revised by the recommendations of detailed engineering study and agreed to by the Commissioner of Environmental Protection in accordance with the following schedule:

- A. On or before January 31, 1984 submit for the review and approval of the Commissioner of Environmental Protection an engineering report with plans and specifications if necessary.
- B. On or before March 31, 1984 verify to the Commissioner of Environmental Protection that implementation of modifications or construction has been started.
- C. On or before May 31, 1984 verify to the Commissioner of Environmental Protection that the constructed facilities have been placed in operation.
