Enclosed you will find Trading Agreement and Order No. 8137 modification for your review and co-signature with Mr. Steven Stafstrom, Director Facilities and Maintenance, AlliedSignal, Inc. Stratford, Connecticut.

Please return the Order signed by an authorized representative of AlliedSignal, Inc. and U.S. Army Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command within fourteen (14) calendar days of your receipt of the Trading Agreement and Order.

The purpose of the modification is to add "joint and several liability" to the Order and SIP and add a statement that the State's Emission Inventory has been revised to reflect appropriate emission rates to satisfy suggestions by EPA in similar previous orders using NOx averaging.

Once the signed Trading Agreement and Order modification is received by the Department, it will be presented to the Commissioner for signature. If signed by the Commissioner, Trading Agreement and Order No. 8137 modification will become a Final Order of the Commissioner and a certified copy of the Trading Agreement and Order will be returned to you via registered mail.
