Harding Lawson Associates, Inc (HLA) is pleased to submit the attached Draft Time-Critical Removal Action Memorandum (TCRAM) for the Chromium Plating Facility at the Stratford Army Engine Plant (SAEP). The proposed removal action consists of in-situ reduction of hexavalent chromium in subsurface soil and groundwater beneath the facility, combined with an Environmental Land-use Restriction for soil beneath the plating facility in Building B-2, if necessary. The alternative technologies consist of excavation and off-site disposal of contaminated soil and conventional groundwater extraction with treatment at SAEP's Chemical Waste Treatment Plant. The estimated costs of the proposed action and the alternative action are also presented in the TCRAM.
