As a follow-up to our meeting with Mr. Seng Phouthakoun and Mr. Jaimeson Sinclair on May 15, 2008, we are submitting this application to request a revision to an existing registration and a permit for two boilers operated at our facility referenced above. This application is being submitted under the provision of Section 22a-174-2a(f)(2)(G) and 22a-174-3a(a)(2)(A)(iii) of RCSA. Specifically, we are requesting that the registration and permit be revised to remove the option to burn oil on these boilers.

Please note that we had initially submitted a letter to Mr. Jaimeson Sinclair on August 22, 2006 requesting these changes. He advised us on May 15, 2008 that the request must be submitted to you along with the pertinent application forms and the application fees. As advised, we are submitting the following documents as part of this application:

**Boiler #2 (Registration revision)**

- It is our understanding that a request to revise a Registration certificate does not require any specific forms and is also not subject to any application or permit fee. Accordingly, no supporting documents are being submitted relative to this request.

**Boiler #3 (Permit revision)**

- Permit Application Transmittal Form;
- Permit Application Form; and,
- An initial application fee of \$375 as stipulated in Section 22a-174-26(b)(3) of RCSA.
