I am pleased to inform you that the NOx RACT sampling program test report for the two Bigelow boilers located in Stratford, CT, which are owned by the US Army Engine Plant and operated by Ferguson-Williams, has been reviewed. Based on our review, we find that all testing was conducted under the required operating conditions and that the equipment tested during this test program appears to be in compliance with the applicable emission limits. The results have been forwarded to the case manager for Trading Order No. 8137A.
