The Solid Waste Management Unit has determined that the above referenced material is suitable for disposal at the Torrington solid waste disposal area, subject to the following condition:

1. it may be used as cover material at the landfill.
2. material should not contain any free draining liquids.

This determination is based on the review of analytical results of soil samples submitted to our office by Textron Lycoming, Stratford.

Permission to dispose of this material must also be obtained from the landfill operator.

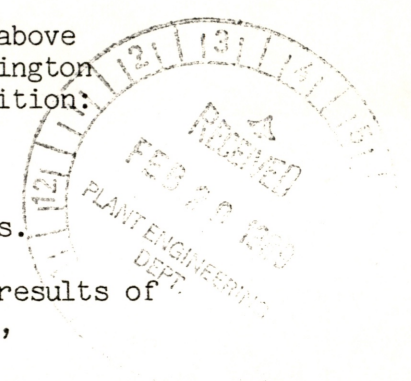
