I am concerned about the recent developments regarding the Stratford Army Engine Plant.

Accordingly, I am requesting a meeting to be fully briefed on the status of the Stratford Army Engine Plant to include answers to the following questions:

- 1. What entity do the Army and GSA recognize as the successful bidders?
- 2. What are the names, addresses and phone numbers of each person that represents the successful bidder that the Army and GSA are working with?
- 3. Where in the process is the Army and GSA in transferring the Stratford Army Engine Plant to the successful bidder?
- 4. What are the next steps and time frames for the next 6 months?
- 5. What is the "drop dead" date for closing before the successful bidder loses its deposit?
- 6. What happens to the Stratford Army Engine Plant if the successful bidder forfeits its deposit?
- 7. Does the Army or GSA have a position on the recent litigation? If so, what is it?
- 8. If not, how has the lawsuit affected dealings with the successful bidder?
