## Notice of Coastal Consistency Review Town of Stratford

The Department of Environmental Protection has received a request submitted by United States Army (the applicant) pursuant to section 307(c)(1) of the Coastal Zone Management Act to review proposed activities for consistency with enforceable policies of Connecticut's federally approved Coastal Management Program contained in sections 22a-90 to 22a-98 of the Connecticut General Statutes. Specifically, the applicant proposes to perform remediation activities on the "Causeway" at Stratford Army Engine Plant, 550 Main Street, Stratford. Such activities will primarily include the construction of an engineered cover system.
