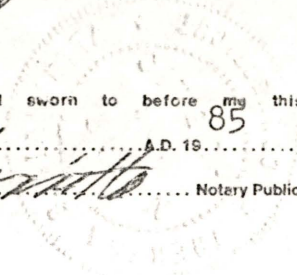

Notice is hereby given that the permittee named above has reapplied to the Commissioner of Environmental Protection for a permit to continue such discharge. The Commissioner of Environmental Protection is authorized to approve or deny the reissuance of such permits pursuant to Section 407(b) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended, 33 USC 1251, et. seq. and Section 22a-430 of the Connecticut General Statutes as amended (hereinafter "the C.G.S.?).

Interested persons who wish to obtain more information regarding the draft permit to be reissued may do so by contacting Richard Mason at 566-7157.

The reapplication, existing permit, draft permit to be reissued, fact sheet, comments received and other information on file with the Department of Environmental Protection may be inspected and copied in the offices of the Department at 122 Washington Street, Hartford, Connecticut 06106 any time between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The draft permit and fact sheet may be obtained by writing to the Director of Water Compliance at the same address.

Prior to making a decision to reissue the draft permit, the Commissioner shall consider comments from interested persons which are received within 30 days of this notice. If the Commissioner decides that there is significant public interest in this matter a public hearing will be held. Notice of any public hearing will be published at least 30 days prior to the hearing.
